(a) Whether there is any Government policy to provide proper School infrastructure in the immediate future in the Hill areas;	(a) Yes.
(b) if so, state the policy; and	(b) The policy of the State Government envisages upgradation of Schools including hostel facilities and teachers quarters in all the blocks of the hill Districts. Under this policy, a project proposal has been prepared with an estimated cost of Rs. 30 crores. The project is scheduled to be completed within 3 years in 3 phases and fund requirement is Rs. 10.00 crores in each year. For the first phase Rs. 10.00 crores has been approved by the Planning Commission under SPA, 2007-08. In addition to this project, there is also another project under SPA, 2007-08 for upgradation of 11(Eleven) numbers of Hr. Sec. Schools in the Hills and Valley Districts.
(c) whether Government has taken steps for posting of full-fledged Headmaster in the Schools of Hill areas?	(c) Yes.
